

WHSBBA Meeting Wednesday, May 7, 2008

Meeting called to order 7:00

Secretary Report

- 1) A review of the secretary's report for the meeting from April 2008 was completed. Minutes were approved.

Treasurer Report

- 1) Financials have been completed through April 2008.
- 2) The contribution by the booster's towards the band trip is \$7,081.10.
- 3) Collections of outstanding balances are still being worked on. Current balance remains \$537. Student's still owing money will not be eligible for leadership positions within the band. The group discussed the possibility of band awards being held back until payments were made; student's won't be able to take exams. Susan will be making phone calls this week to see if any progress can be made.
- 4) Scholarship update—we have one student that still owes 21.5 hours. Another student still owes 1 hour.
- 5) An additional \$150 deposit is due for the 2009 Band banquet. A motion was made to approve the payment of this additional deposit and was approved by all.
- 6) Pizza Hut Park Concessions will bring in approximately \$4,200 plus tips of \$434.30 for a total of \$4,634.30.
- 7) Students must have made all payments and be current in order to sign p for a band banquet table. This includes and outstanding balances to the booster's, jazz, reeds, etc.
- 8) Hype day budget is \$200. Still need to purchase 4 more boxes of hot dogs and 21 packages of buns totaling just over \$100.

New Business

- 1) Presentation of New Bylaws at Spring Concert: Laura Sammons will email us the form that will be presented at the concert.
- 2) Presentation of New Board at Spring Concert: An email will go out outlining the 2008-2009 Organizational Chart that will be presented at the concert.
- 3) Spring Banquet: Still pushing ticket sales. An email went out with the ticket order form attached to encourage sign up. Door prizes have been bought and decorations are being pulled together. Once paid, students can sign up for their table. Discussion took place regarding the booster providing complimentary tickets to the directors and their guests, Mr. Farish and Mrs. Heard. This would amount to an approximate cost of \$250 for the boosters. If we sell about 250 tickets to the banquet, we should be able to handle the expense easily. A motion was made to approve our providing these complimentary tickets and was approved by all.
- 4) Senior Awards: Susan and Anders are working on two frames pictures to be presented to each senior—one senior group photo and individual pictures of the students with their instrument. The plaques should be in any day. Dottie Jordan will put together a program for the banquet.
- 5) Transition Meeting: Possible dates for this meeting with the 2008-2009 new board were discussed. June 3rd is the proposed date at 7:00 in the Band Hall.

All current board members should attend and bring any items that should be passed off to the new board member.

- 6) Booster Party: 27 positive RSVP's so far.
- 7) Upcoming Important Dates: 5/15 & 5/16 Griffin Concerts, 5/17 Hype Day, 5/20 Staley Concert, 5/27 New Member Meeting, 5/29 Spring Concert, 5/31 Banquet.
- 8) Announcements: John Hamer announced that next Tuesday night the Frisco Community Band has a concert at Wakeland. Mr. Miller will be a guest and will play his clarinet. The band will play a couple of pieces with the Wakeland String Orchestra. The Frisco All-City Choir will be singing as well.

Leadership interviews are taking place now. Drum major tryouts are tomorrow. Postings will go up no later than Saturday.

The Wind Symphony has a concert at UNT on May 15th. 4:50 is their performance time. This will be a recording session for honor band.

The students will get the music next week for next year's show.
